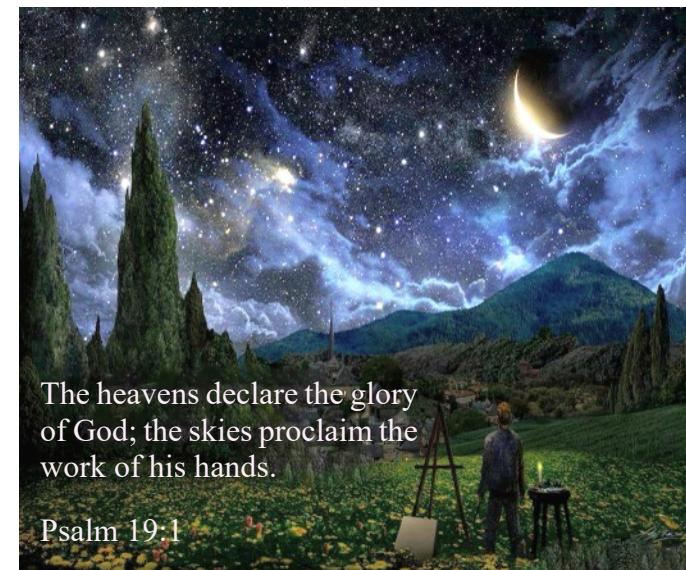

NEC Day of Fellowship

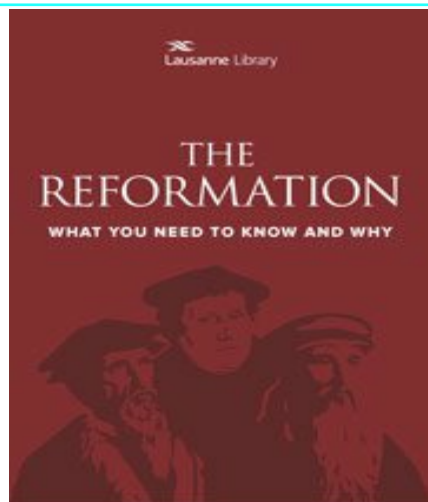
Please note that all tickets for the day of Fellowship in Birmingham on Sabbath 28th October have now been sold. No ticket, no entry.
