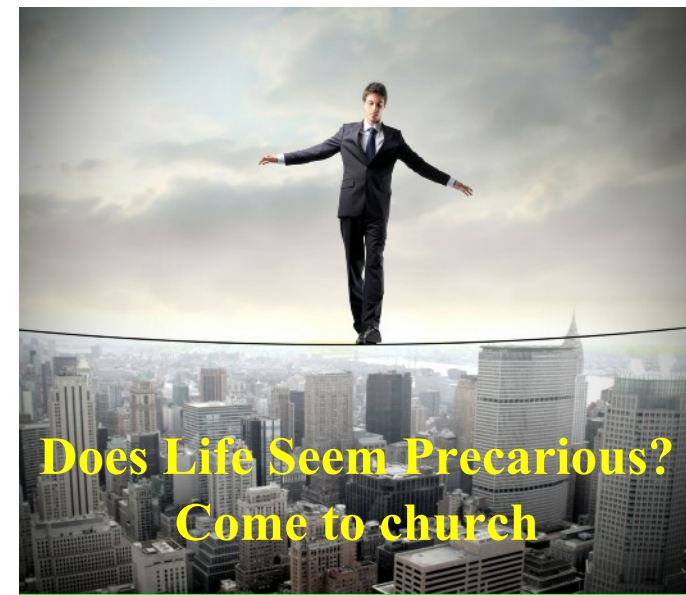

Alice Bell (1910 - 2009), became an assistant minister, first In Glasgow and then in South Wales. She met her husband (George Bell) also a minister in the Seventh-day Adventist church. She remained active supporting him, giving Bible studies, assisting at children's camps and cooking under wartime conditions. She describes the two world wars and remained active until her death.

After she reached 70 years of age, she was free to travel and studied at Birmingham and Oxford Universities and spent time researching and writing on Genesis, the Gospels and the life of Paul. She preached and gave talks in many different churches and meeting places until her death. Her three books are unique in their substance and she will be of interest to both Christians and non-believers alike.
