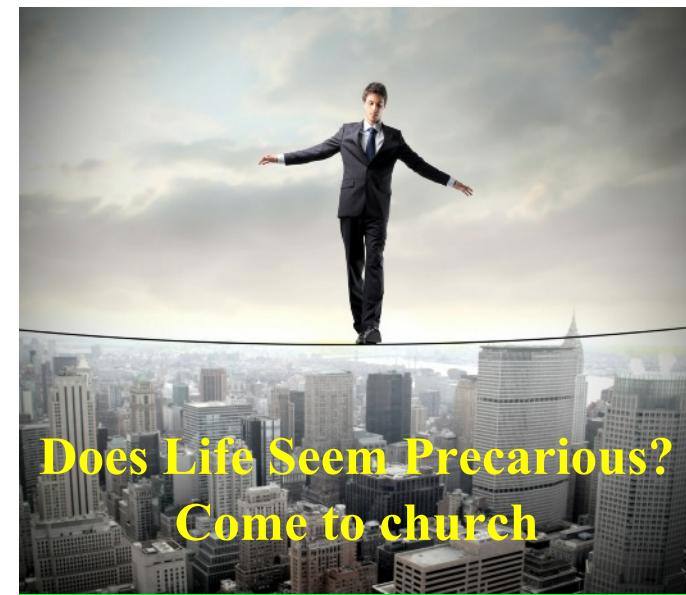

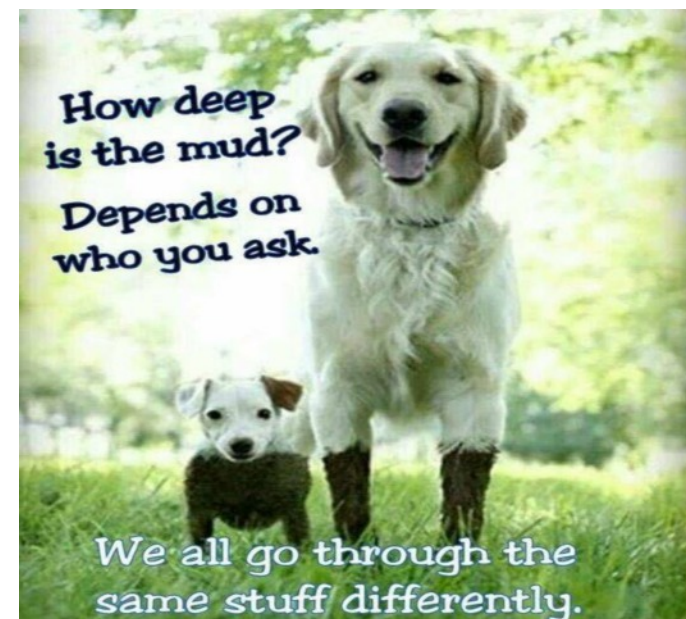
Diary of Events
